TRANSPORTATION SERVICE IN PARTNERSHIP

With the

Jewish Community Center - Children at Play (CAP) Program

I. Registration for the CAP PROGRAM must take place first:

The Jewish Community Center provides quality care for families that need childcare for their elementary school age students before the school day starts and after the school day ends. **Parents must register their students for the CAP Program prior to requesting bus transportation.** The CAP program has 2 locations: Meadow Brook School for students in grades K-2 and Mapleshade School for students in grades 3-5.

II. Registration for Bus Transportation:

Parents must complete a bus registration form in order to obtain service.

III. The school district's transportation policy states that one morning designated bus stop and one afternoon designated bus stop is allowed for each student for every school day. The impact of this policy is as follows:

- Meadow Brook and Mapleshade students whose designated afternoon bus stop is home, but are enrolled in the two-day or three-day-a-week afternoon program, must notify the school administration so that those students do not get on the bus on their scheduled CAP days.
- Mountain View students enrolled in the two-day or three-day-a-week afternoon program will have Mapleshade School as their designated stop. Travel arrangements to get students home on the other days of the week must be made by parents.

IV. Additional information for parents of Mountain View Students who attend the CAP Program:

1. A direct shuttle bus will take students from Mapleshade School to Mountain View School in the morning and bring Mountain View students to Mapleshade School in the afternoon.
2. Students who live more than 2 miles from Mountain View, no fee will be charged.
3. Students who live less than 2 miles from Mountain View, the following fees apply:
 - a. \$270 per year for those students who will be riding a regularly scheduled morning or afternoon school bus.
 - b. \$90 for students who will only be riding the shuttle bus to or from Mapleshade School.
