Directors Report:

- **Excise Tax Bills:** Ms. Bishop shared with the newer RMV software there are some changes to the actual excise bills and how we will be handling certain excise bills that are entitled to an exemption. First the excise bills will no longer be rounded off and will be billed to the penny. This is due to the Department of Revenue directing the RMV to the need of assessing the actual tax dollars to the penny in order to comply with the law. Secondly, the newer format makes it hard to flag certain bills that may be exempt. Technically, a taxpayer who is exempt should request an excise abatement annually. The process is very simple by filling out the abatement/exemption application on the back of the bill and returning it to the office. There are approximately 25 bills out of 15,000 who will have to annually request the exemption. Lastly, the RMV is now including all Section 5 Plates (Farmer, Dealer and OCN) in the regular commitment. Previously, this office received these types of Excise bills in its own commitment.

Ms. Bishop stated the excise bills are anticipated to be mailed on February 10th and due March 10th or 11th.

- **GIS and Property Cards:** In working with our GIS department, the mapping area of the town's GIS is beginning to have some changes to better assist the people who utilize our maps.
- **Vision Version 8 Upgrade Scheduled:** The Vision Upgrade took place on January 21, 2020. I will be reviewing the problematic areas and see if they are now resolved. Once I review and continue using the software I will be able to eliminate prior issues and hopefully catch any new ones that may have popped up in the upgrade.

Mr. Grudgen made a motion to go into executive session to review FY20 Real Estate Statutory Exemptions; FY 20 Real Estate Abatements; FY19 ATB Update; to return to open session to record any votes if needed and adjourn.
