## First Town Meeting

### July 9, 1894

Town Meeting July 9 <sup>th</sup> , 1894	First Town Meeting of the Town of East Longmeadow, July 9 <sup>th</sup> , 1894, called to order by O.L. Wolcott, justice of the peace under authority and direction of Chap. 418 of Acts of 1894 incorporating the town and warrant for meeting read.
Tellers	Edward M. Burt and John L. Davis appointed tellers and sworn by O.L. Wolcott, Justice of the Peace.
Moderator	J. M. Burt elected Moderator having twenty-two (22) votes. J.C. Pease had twenty (20) votes and, E. Endicott had three (3) votes.
Town Clerk	O. Louis Wolcott elected Town Clerk having eighty-nine (89) votes. W. H. Hall had two (2) votes, there were also two votes for O. L. Wolcott Treas. cast with vote for clerk. O.L. Wolcott duly sworn as Clerk by Moderator.
Town Treas.	O. L. Wolcott elected Town Treasurer having eighty-nine (89) votes. W. H. Hall has two votes and there were also two votes for O. L. Wolcott Clerk cast with vote for Treasurer. O. L. Wolcott duly sworn as Treasurer by Moderator.
3 Selectmen to serve until next An. Meeting	Voted to choose three Selectmen. Voted that officers chosen shall serve until the next annual town meeting.
Fence viewer	Voted to choose two fence viewers and C. H. Bugbee and Charles L. McIntosh chosen.
Field Drivers	Voted to choose three field drivers by nomination and O. H. Coomes, Leon Cooley and Asher Markham were so chosen.
No. of Tax Collectors	Voted to choose one tax collector.
No. of Auditors Selectmen	Voted to choose two Auditors. George B. Robinson, J. F. Whitaker and Edward S. Ellis elected selectmen and were duly sworn by Town Clerk. The detailed vote for selectmen was as follows:
Detail voter for Selectmen	J. F. Whitaker had thirty-one (31) votes A. H. Calkins had thirty-one (31) votes J. C. Porter had twenty-seven (27) votes Ethan Hancock had forty (40) votes Geo. W. No. of Assessors	Charles Bugbee had one (1) vote Voted to choose three Assessors
Assessors	George B. Robinson & J. F. Whitaker elected assessors each having two (2) votes. No vote for other persons for assessor were cast.
Oath	Edward L. Ellis And the assessors oath in form prescribed by law was administered to above named by O.L. Wolcott, Town Clerk.
Overseers of the Poor	Voted to choose three overseers of the poor. Geo. B. Robinson, J. P. Whitaker and Edward S. Ellis elected overseers of the poor and sworn by clerk. The detailed vote for same was as follows: Geo. B. Robinson had six (6) votes. J. F. Whitaker had six (6) votes. E. S. Ellis had eight (8) votes. J. C. Porter had two (2) votes. E. Hancock had two (2) votes. Mrs. O. C. Hunn had two (2) votes. Mrs. Billings Cooley had two (2) votes. Mrs. H. A. Fiske had two (2) votes.
Tax Collector Sworn	Arthur g. Crane elected tax collector and sworn by O. L. Wolcott clerk. The vote for Tax collector was as follows: Arthur G. Crane had forty (40) votes. M. A. Glynn had nine (9) votes.
Weighers of coal	Voted to choose three weighers of coal by nomination. G. S. Wood, E. S. Griswold and E. H. Coomes elected. Also afterward voted to choose two additional weighers of coal and F. A. Crane and J. F. Whitaker were chosen.
Auditors	A. D. Smith and Edwin Indicott were chosen auditors and sworn by O. L. Wolcott town Clerk. The detailed voted for Auditor was as follows: A. D. Smith had six (6) ballots. Edwin Indicott had seven (7) “. J. M Burt had four (4) “. W. S. Chaplin had four (4) “. E. M. burt had four (4) “. O. H. Coomes had four (4) “. F. H. Crane had two (2) “. Geo. Thomas had one (1) “. John Davis had one (1) ”. J. L. Burke had one (1) “.
No. of Highway Surveyors Highway	Voted to elect two highway surveyors. Fred Dwight and Asher Markham were elected and duly sworn by Town Clerk. The detailed vote for Highway Surveyor was as follows:

School Ethan Hancock, J. L. Davis and O. L. Wolcott were elected. Misterys Hancock and  
 Committee Davis were sworn by Town Clerk and Wolcott was sworn by.

 J. L. Davis had sixty-three votes. (63)  
 O. L. Wolcott had sixty-six votes. (66)  
 M. A. Glynn had three votes. (3)  
 J. Morgan had one vote. (1)

Constables Voted to choose two Constables.  
 George S. Wood and George Cook were elected and George Cook duly sworn by Town  
 Clerk.  
 The detailed vote for same was as follows:  
 George S. Wood has thirty-one (31) votes.  
 George Cook had twenty-six (26) votes.  
 A. G. Crane had four (4) votes.  
 N. C. Dickinson had eleven (11) votes.  
 J. F. Norcross had one (1) vote.  
 Billings Cooley had three (3) votes.  
 Mr. A. Glynn had two (2) votes.  
 George Smith had one (1) vote.  
 Nils Nilson had one (1) vote.
