Step 1

Pour out liquids



Why?

Liquids make the trash heavy. At home, you wouldn't throw away a water bottle with out pouring the liquid in the sink.

Place milk cartons in barrel

Step 2



Why?

Milk cartons are recyclable but are made out of different materials than water bottles so must be separated.

Trash



Why?

Sporks, straws, wrappers, plastic baggies. These plastics are made of a different type of plastic and can't be recycled. They last for 1000 years.



Container Recycling




Why?

Clean and empty containers can be remade into new containers, fleece jackets, or insulation.

Compost- Food and paper

Compost (food and paper)



Why?

Food waste buried in landfills creates harmful carbon dioxide gas. If we instead compost our food and paper (napkins), the combination of worms, heat, and mixing will turn the food back into nutrient rich soil that can be reused in gardens and at farms.

Remember...

- Organize your tray before coming up to the stations.

- Place all trash items together.
- Place all food and napkins together.
- Empty any containers of food on your plate.
