Commission for People with Disabilities

two vacancies

Pursuant to MGL Chapter 40, Section 8J, the purpose of the Commission is to coordinate or carry out programs in coordination with programs of the Massachusetts Office on Disability in order to bring about full and equal participation in all aspects of life in the Town for people with disabilities. The majority of the members shall consist of people with disabilities. One of the members may be a member of the immediate family of a person with a disability. One member shall be either an elected or appointed official of the Town.

Conservation Commission

two vacancies

The Conservation Commission consists of seven members appointed by the Town Manager. Appointments are for staggered three-year terms. The purpose of the Commission is to promote and develop the natural resources of the Town, to protect the wetlands and watershed areas of the Town, and to permit and regulate development within wetland areas.

Cultural Council

one vacancy

Consists of nine members appointed by the Town Manager. Appointments are for staggered three-year terms. Members are limited to two consecutive terms. The purpose of the council is to promote cultural activities in the community and to facilitate and coordinate the distribution of state arts lottery funds.

Historical Commission

one vacancy

Consists of not less than three, and no more than seven members appointed by the Town Manager. Appointments are for staggered three-year terms. The purpose of the Commission is to preserve and protect the Town's historical artifacts. The Commission also works to promote and develop the Town's historical assets for present and future use, and oversees the operation of the Historical Museum and the Library's History Room.

Housing Authority

one vacancy

The Housing Authority runs four housing programs. The mission of the Housing Authority is to provide decent, safe, affordable housing for the low income elderly, veterans, disabled and families. The Housing Authority consists of five members, four appointed by the Town Manager and one being appointed by the Governor, for staggered five-year terms. One member is a Tenant Representative who is recommended by the Tenant Association.

Recreation Commission

one vacancy

Consists of five members appointed by the Town Manager. Appointments are for staggered three-year terms. The Commission provides guidance to the Recreation Director regarding programs, long range planning, use of parks, fields and facilities, and the review of the Recreation Department's budget.

Zoning Board of Appeals

two associate vacancies

The Zoning Board of Appeals hears and decides applications for special permits, petitions for zoning variances, and appeals in accordance with State and Town zoning regulations. The Board consists of five regular members (three year terms) and two associates (one year terms) appointed by the Town Manager.
