



NEWS FROM THE SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM

The East Longmeadow Food Service Program would like to provide the parents and/or guardians of school aged children with updated information regarding the lunch program.

Lunch prices will remain the same for the 2019-2020 school year. High School and Birchland Park students will pay \$3.00 per lunch and the cost of a meal at the elementary level is \$2.50. Individual cartons of milk will be sold for 40¢.

We will continue to utilize our automated Point of Sale equipment in all of the cafeterias. It is imperative that all students present their ID badge to the cashier when they proceed through the lunch line. This will ensure the efficiency and accuracy of each transaction.

As a reminder, parents/guardians have the ability to manage their child's meal account over the internet by using PaySchoolsCentral.com, an online school lunch management tool. This secure website can be accessed directly at <https://PaySchoolsCentral.com>. This program has become very popular and many have commented on the ease and convenience of using it.
