WASTE because:

- Waste must be out by 7:00 A.M.
- Waste exceeds volume limit one 35 gallon container or one bag
- Waste exceeds weight limit (50 lbs)
- Yard waste mixed with household waste (yard waste may not be disposed of with household waste by state mandate)
- Bulky waste is not collected with household waste at the curbside (Call Republic Services at 413-557-6700 for special bulk waste pick up. Fees will apply.)

RECYCLABLES because:

- This is paper week, not bottles and cans week
- This is bottle and cans week, not paper week
- Recyclables should not be in plastic bags
- Paper products need to be separated from glass/plastic and cans
- All recyclables must be clean and free of food contamination
- These materials are not accepted in your recycling program
- Boxes must be flattened and cut into 2' x 2' pieces to fit into the vehicle
