The applicant above agrees to take all necessary measures to ensure against damage to pavements, curbing, berms, planting, drainage systems, or other elements within the public rail trail, including installation of a slit filtration fence if ordered by the DPW. Damage would include, but is not limited to, erosion from the property being developed, movement of heavy equipment, rail trail or street openings, or other causes within control of the applicant.

The following work must be completed:

- 1. Aprons must extend a minimum of 15 feet from edge of trail or as specified on this permit.**
- 2. All disturbed shoulders must be loamed and seeded a minimum of 15 feet from edge of trail or as specified on this permit.**
