


2019-2020 Trash & Recycling Collection

Curbside Trash & Recycling Collection Schedule: Trash & recycling is collected every week on your regular collection day. Residents may use any 35 gallon barrel or one 35 gallon bag for trash. Residents may use any container with a recycling sticker on it for recycling. Recycling stickers and recycling containers available for free at Health Dept.

 All paper products are collected during the weeks highlighted in purple.

 All highlighted commingled containers are collected during the weeks highlighted in blue.

Holiday Schedule: When a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are circled.

 Holiday: No curbside collection.

East Longmeadow Recycles!

2019-2020 TRASH REDUCTION & RECYCLING PROGRAM

THE TOWN OF EAST LONGMEADOW HAS REGULATIONS THAT LIMIT BARREL SIZE TO 35 GALLONS AND MAKE RECYCLING MANDATORY.

Program Details:

- Place your trash/recycling curbside by 7am on your pick up day.
- You may have up to one 35 gallon bag or barrel of trash.
- Anything over 35 gallons needs to be placed in official town bags or it will not be collected.
- Official town bags are available at local stores or town hall.
- Trash that contains recyclables will not be collected.
- No recyclables in plastic bags will be accepted.
- Plastic bags are not recyclable in curbside recycling collection (return to retailers).

Textile Recycling:

SimpleRecycling curbside collection on your trash/recycling day.
Call SimpleRecycling for bags: 866-835-5068 or visit town hall.
Textiles also collected at Salvation Army bin behind fire station.
Moldy, wet or oily textiles not accepted.

Somers Road Transfer Station Accepts:

Leaves, yard waste, electronics, appliances, bulky waste, wood, batteries, used motor oil, furniture, light bulbs, mattresses, and metal.
An annual Transfer Station sticker costs \$50. Additional fees may apply. Call the DPW at (413)525-5400, ext. 1200 for more info.
