**About Us:** The East Longmeadow Conservation Commission is responsible for protecting wetlands resources in town. We follow Wetlands Regulations (310 CMR 10.00). The Commission meets on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at 6 PM to review Conservation filings. The Commission also conducts site visits based on filings from applicants and/or for reported Wetlands violations. These visits may occur prior to a meeting or as otherwise scheduled to accommodate the applicant or the Commission.

**Requirements:**

- Access to a computer and the internet
- Reliable Transportation
- Experience not required. Training opportunities are available.
- Applicants with previous knowledge of the Wetlands Protection Act and/or experience with conservation efforts are encouraged to apply.
